



CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIP 2012 APPLICATION SPECIFICATIONS

Type A/ One Semester Scholarship

This scholarship is available to outstanding Confucius Institute students, HSK exam high achievers, Winners of “Chinese Bridge” Chinese proficiency competitions for foreign college students and for foreign high school students, Chinese teachers worldwide, and outstanding Chinese language students worldwide.

Applicants can choose to study Chinese Language and Literature, Chinese History and Chinese Philosophy. The scholarship lasts for one semester and is available in autumn semester 2012 or spring semester 2013.

Applicants must:

- **have studied at the Confucius Institute for at least 60 hours**
- **or have achieved at least 120 in the new HSK (level 2)***

Type B/ One Academic Year Scholarship

This scholarship is available to outstanding Confucius Institute students, HSK exam high achievers, Winners of “Chinese Bridge” Chinese proficiency competitions for foreign college students and for foreign high school students, Chinese teachers worldwide, and outstanding graduates of Chinese language, or those who intend to become Chinese teachers.

Applicants can choose to study Chinese Language and Literature, Chinese History and Chinese Philosophy. The scholarship lasts for 1 year from autumn 2012.

Applicants must:

- **have studied at the Confucius Institute for at least 120 hours**
- **or have achieved at least 180 in the new HSK (level 3)***

Type C/ Master programme scholarship in teaching Chinese to speakers of other languages (2 years)

This scholarship is available to outstanding Confucius Institute students, HSK exam high achievers, Winners of “Chinese Bridge” Chinese proficiency competitions for foreign college students and for foreign high school students, Chinese teachers worldwide, and outstanding graduates of Chinese language.

The scholarship lasts for 2 years from autumn 2012. After successful completion of the study, the candidates will be awarded Master’s degree in MTC SOL and graduate certificate.

Applicants must:

- **hold bachelor degree or equivalent**
- **have achieved at least 180 in the new HSK (level 5)***
- **provide a written commitment stating that s/he will be engaged in Chinese language teaching for at least 5 years after graduation.**
